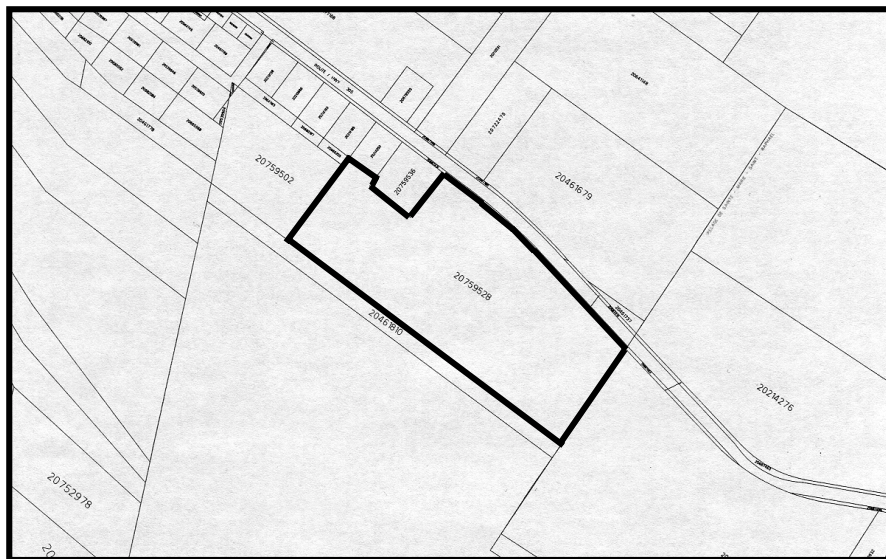


## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

### Lamèque and Miscou Islands

Pursuant to Section 68 of the *Community Planning Act*, the Minister of the Environment and Local Government is considering adoption by Ministerial Regulation of the following amendment to the Rural Plan Regulation (97-ILM-018-00) and the Regulations amending the Rural Plan Act (97-ILM-018-01, 02-ILM-018-02 and 03-ILM-018-03) for the unincorporated areas of Lamèque and Miscou Islands – *Community Planning*):

The amendment relates to the lands, having PID # 20759528 indicated on the map, owned by La Tourbière du Grand Lac Ltée (Mr. Euclide Chiasson). This amendment is to re-zone the lands from, M1 Zone (Mixed, Residential, Commercial, Industrial and Institutional) and R Zone (Rural) to a TB Zone (Peatland) so as to accommodate a peat bog operation. The property is located along Route 305 in the Local Service District of Haut-Lamèque, near the village of Sainte-Marie-Saint-Raphaël.



A public meeting to hear objections to the proposed amendments will be held at 7:00 p.m. on March 3, 2004, at Club De L'Âge D'Or of Lamèque, 62 rue de l'École.
